Background

- ❑ The Cisco Security Enterprise License Agreement is a suite of security applications to protect sensitive data and resources
- ❑ Leveraging the tools in the suite gives Information Technology the necessary tools to protect against ever-growing cyber threats
- ❑ The City has deployed the following applications from the suite
 - ▣ Advanced Malware Protection for Endpoints
 - ▣ Identity Services Engine
 - ▣ Umbrella
 - ▣ FirePower Intrusion Detection System/Intrusion Prevention System

Background continued

- Netsync is a certified Cisco partner and pricing is through the Texas Department of Information Resources DIR-TSO-4167
- Cost of the Network Security Enterprise Agreement is \$58,842.63 per year for three years; total not to exceed \$176,527.88

Alternatives

4

- Do not authorize the purchase of Cisco Network Security Enterprise Agreement
 - ▣ Doing so will inhibit the city's ability to minimize the risk of attacks on network systems, daily operations and exposure of sensitive data
- Authorize the purchase of Cisco Network Security Enterprise Agreement not to exceed \$176,527.88

Recommendation

5

- Staff recommends that the City Manager or his designee be authorized to execute a Cisco Network Security Enterprise Agreement from Netsync Network Solutions in the amount not to exceed \$176,527.88 over a three-year period using the Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) TSO 4167 contract
