Background

- The City invests in accordance with the Public Funds Investment Act (PFIA), ensuring safety and prudent management of public funds.
- Current investments types are:
 - Government-Backed Securities
 - State and Local Obligations
 - Deposits and Accounts

Texas Class – Investment Pool

- □ Texas CLASS is a local government investment pool that pools funds to earn competitive dividends, complying with the Public Funds Investment Act and Texas laws, while focusing on safety and liquidity.
- Texas Class carry a AAAm rating from S&P Global Ratings
- Texas Class Government Yield as of August 30, 2024, month end was 5.25%

- Investing a portion of the City's resources in Texas Connect would benefit the City by:
 - Providing greater diversification
 - Providing more flexibility
 - Providing a competitive return on the City's assets
- Participation in Texas Connect will not undermine the existing depository contract.

Staff recommends that City Council Approve the participation of the City in the Texas Class investment pool, and authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute the agreement.
