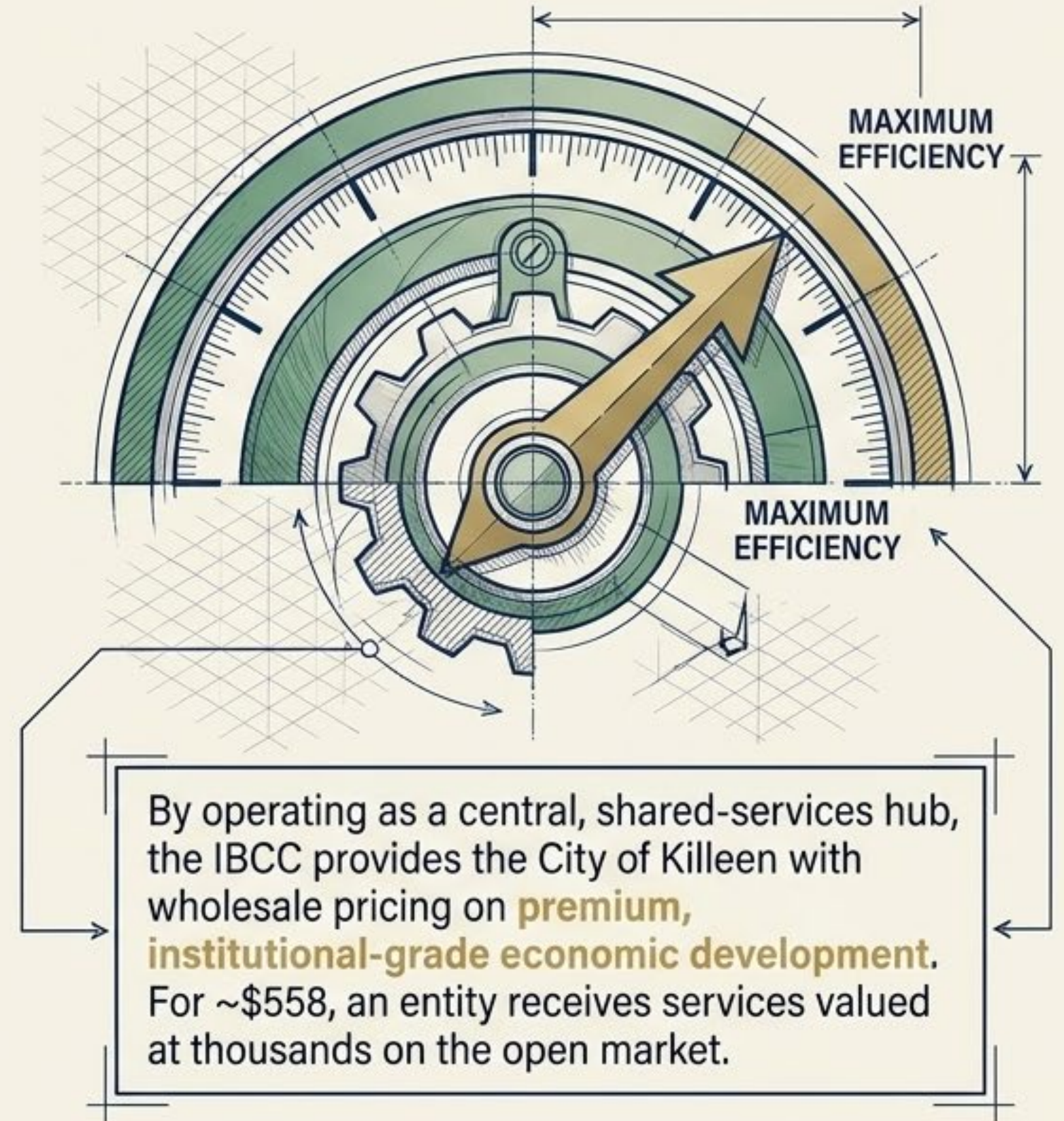

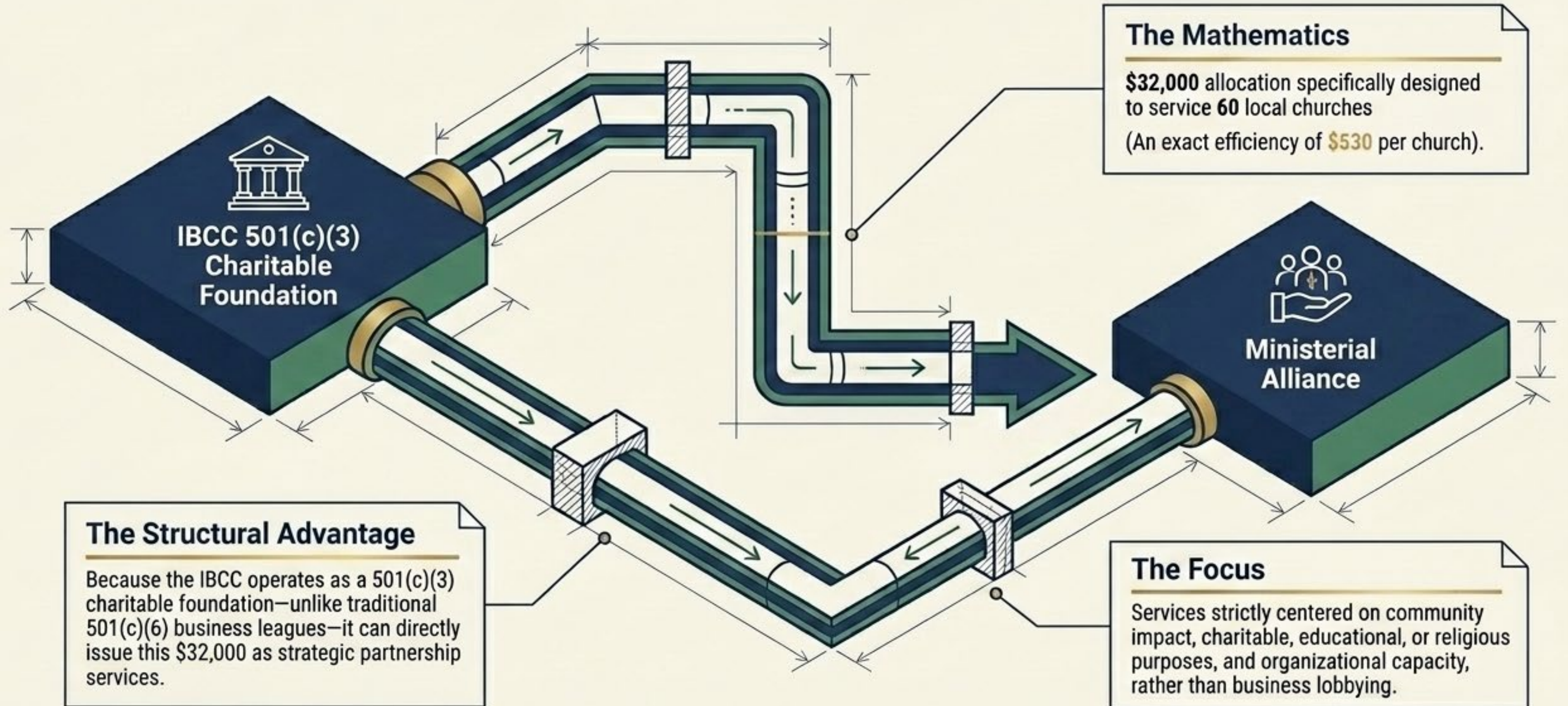
The Tiered Service Architecture



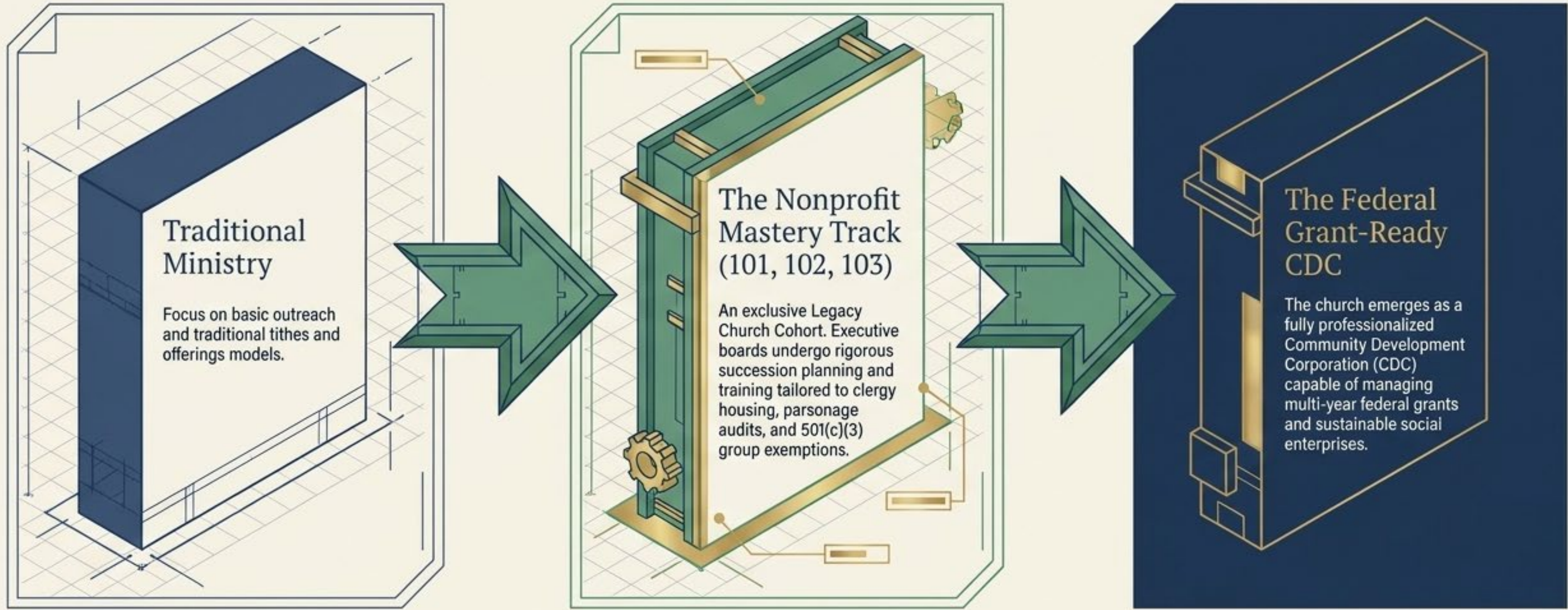
The Capability Escalator



Mobilizing the Ministerial Community: A \$32,000 Strategic Services

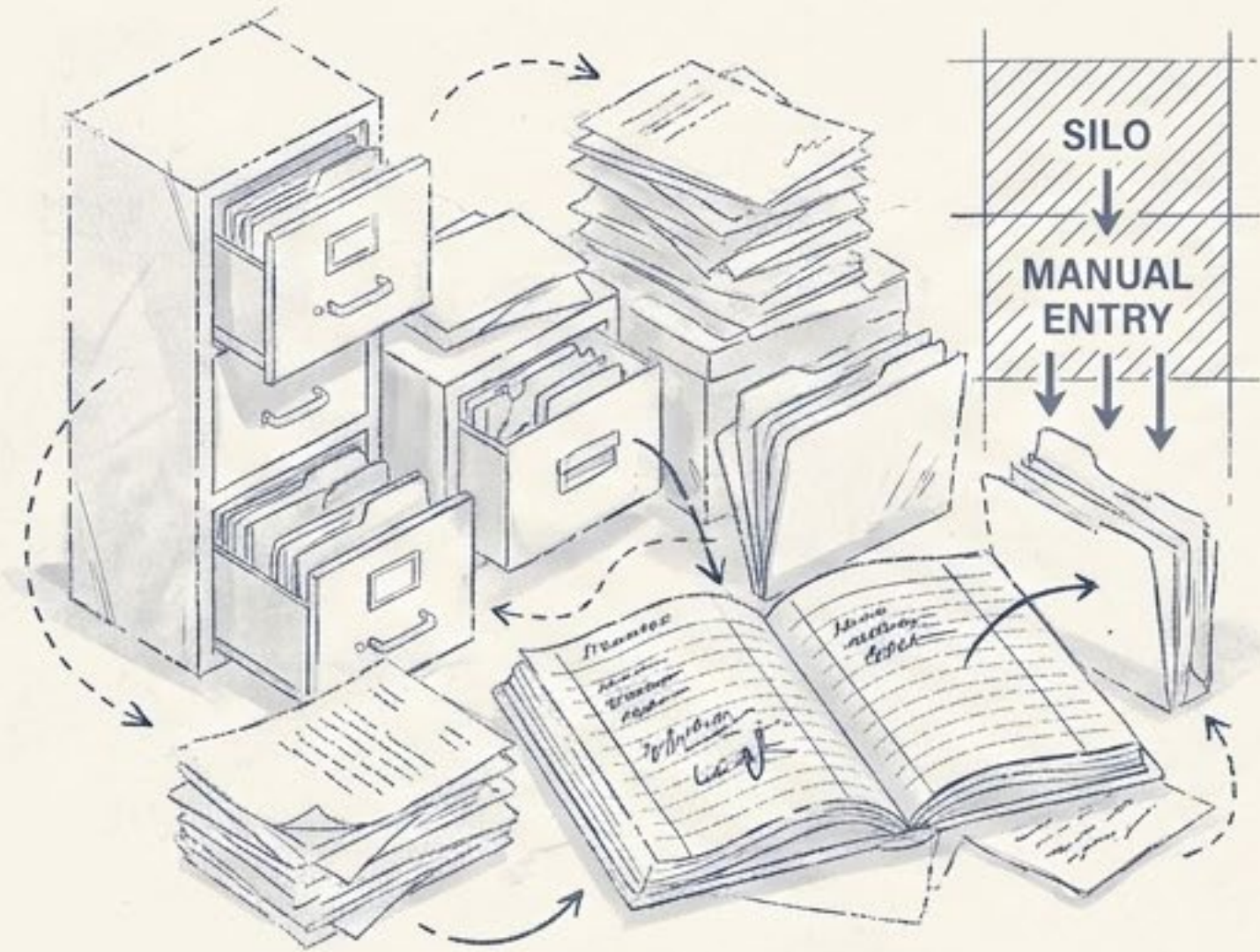


The Legacy Church Transformation Metamorphosis



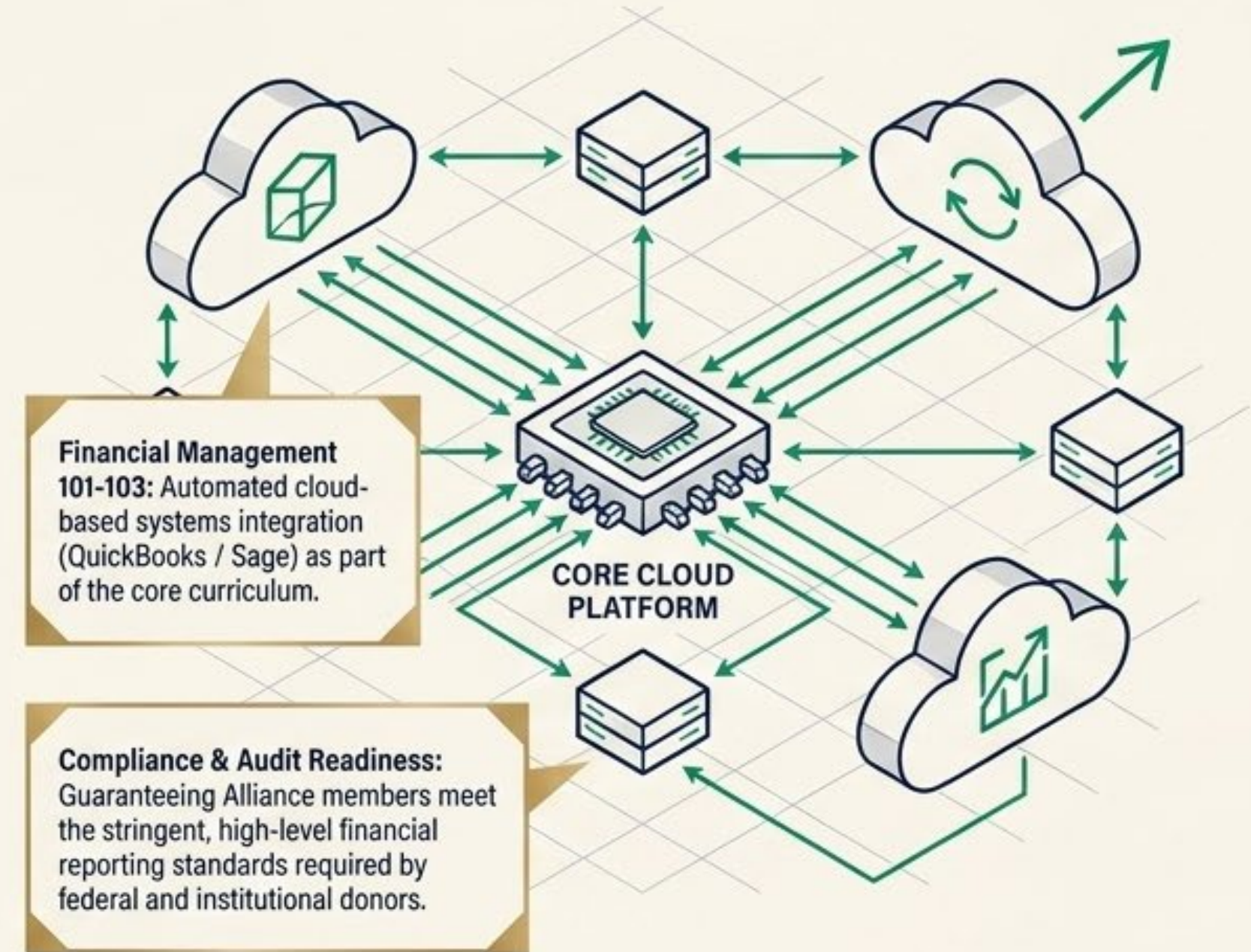
Digital Transformation for Ministry Back-Offices

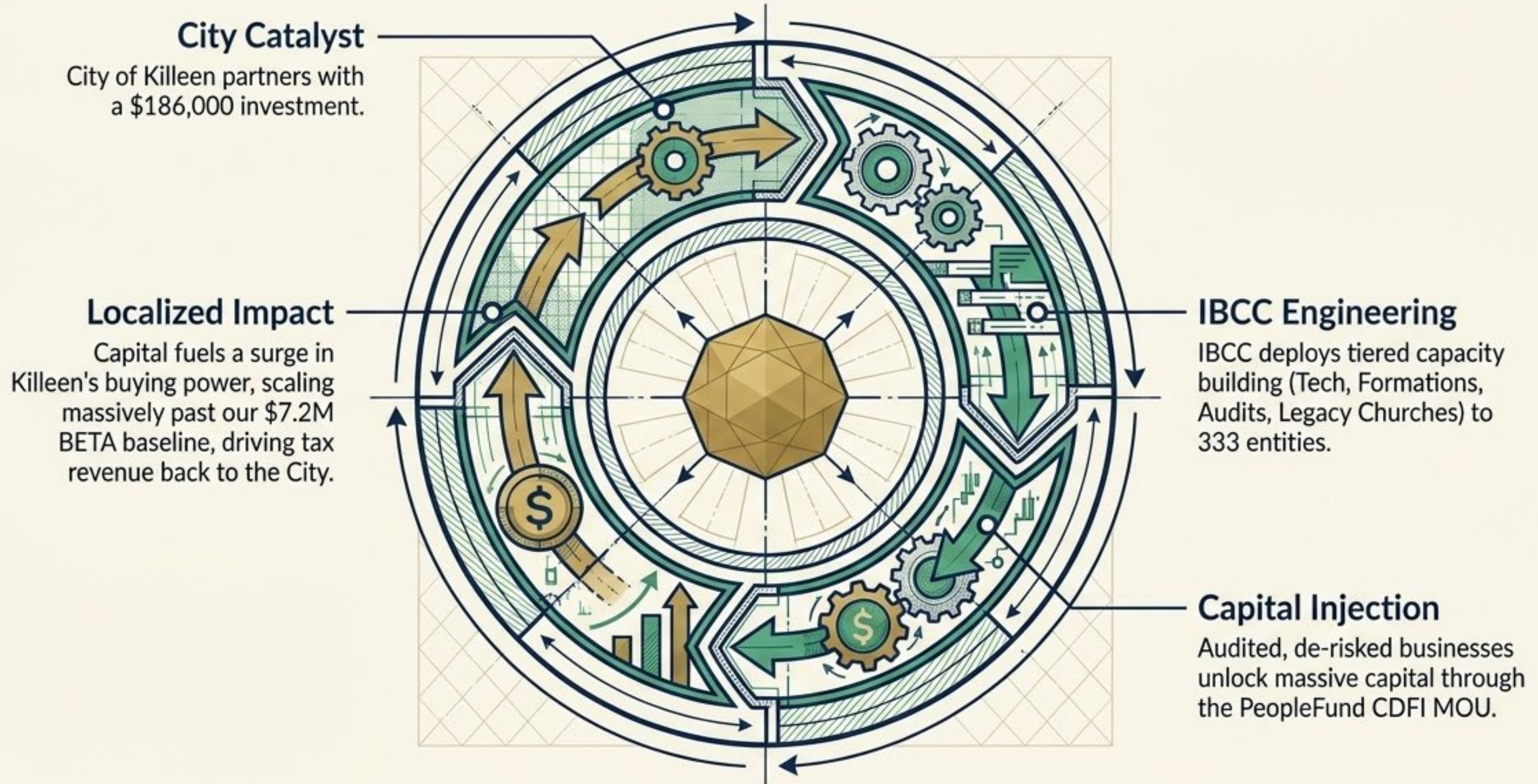
