# Background

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- The City has been utilizing the Geographic Information Systems (GIS) software licenses and technical support from Environmental Systems Research Institute (ESRI) since 2001
- The software being renewed is used at many levels within the city and supports access to GIS information available to the citizens via the web
- The Core software included is ArcGIS Desktop, ArcGIS Pro, ArcGIS Server, ArcGIS Data store, ArcSDE spatial database engine, and several ArcGIS analyst extensions

# Background

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- Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. provides essential Geographic Information System (GIS) services and software to City staff and community members through internal and external websites
- The Information Technology Department is seeking approval of a one-year agreement with ESRI for GIS software using DIR contract DIR-CPO-4699 in the amount of \$52,468

# Recommendation

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- Staff recommends that the City Council approve the one-year agreement with ESRI in the amount of \$52,468 using DIR-CPO-4699, and that the City Manager or designee be expressly authorized to execute any and all change orders within the amounts set by state and local law
