

ESRI SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT RENEWAL

Background

The City has been utilizing the Geographic Information Systems (GIS) software licenses and technical support from Environmental Systems Research Institute (ESRI) since 2001

The software being renewed is used at many levels within the city and supports access to GIS information available to the citizens via the web

 The Core software included is ArcGIS Desktop, ArcGIS Pro, ArcGIS Server, ArcGIS Data store, ArcSDE spatial database engine, and several ArcGIS analyst extensions

The City's GIS Enterprise system supports a range of key maps and apps within a local government as summarized below:

The Information Technology Department is seeking approval of a one-year agreement with ESRI for GIS software using DIR contract DIR-CPO-4699 in the amount of \$52,468

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the one-year agreement with ESRI in the amount of \$52,468 using DIR-CPO-4699, and that the City Manager or designee be expressly authorized to execute any and all change orders within the amounts set by state and local law
