

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN'S FUTURE LAND USE MAP FROM 'RURAL' TO 'GENERAL COMMERCIAL' FOR 3.754 ACRES OUT OF THE THOMAS ROBINETT SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 686, GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF WATERCREST ROAD, NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF WATERCREST ROAD AND CODY POE ROAD IN KILLEEN, TEXAS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Killeen finds that Chapter 213.003 of the Local Government Code enables municipalities to adopt and amend comprehensive plans in the interest of coordinating long-range development of the municipality.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission has received a request from Lindsey Emmons for a revision to the Future Land Use Map (FLUM) of the Comprehensive Plan, to change 3.754 acres out of the Thomas Robinett Survey, abstract No. 686, generally located on the north side of Watercrest Road, north of the intersection of Watercrest Road and Cody Poe Road in Killeen, Texas from 'Rural' to 'General Commercial'; said revision having been duly presented and recommended for approval of 'General Commercial' by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Killeen on the 21st day of August 2017, and due notice of the filing of said revision and the date of hearing thereon was given as required by law, and hearing on said request was set for 5:00 P.M., on the 12th day of September 2017, at the City Hall, City of Killeen;

WHEREAS, the City Council at said hearing duly considered said request, the action of the Planning and Zoning Commission and the evidence in support thereof, and the City Council being of the opinion that the amendment should be approved;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
KILLEEN, TEXAS:**

SECTION I: That the land use designation of 3.754 acres out of the Thomas Robinett Survey, Abstract No. 686, being generally located on the north side of Watercrest Road, north of the intersection of Watercrest Road and Cody Poe Road in Killeen, Texas, be amended from 'Rural' to 'Suburban Commercial' as illustrated in Exhibit 1.

SECTION II. That should any section or part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or parts of this ordinance.

SECTION III. That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage of the ordinance.
