- City Charter, Sections 111-118, outlines the recall procedure for the Mayor and City Council
- A recall affidavit was filed Friday, July 26, 2024, requesting the resignation or recall of District 4 Councilmember, Michael Boyd
- □ The required number of signatures for the recall petition was 202 based on a voter turnout of 401 for the June 12, 2021 Second Election for District 4

- Petition blanks were issued on Monday, July 29, 2024, and were to be returned to the CSO by Wednesday, August 28, 2024
- Petitioner submitted the recall petition on August 28,
 2024, with a total of 341 signatures
- □ Review of the petition has been completed as follows:
 - 218 signatures of qualified electors within the respective district
 - 123 signatures were unqualified

- Recall petition for District 4 Councilmember Boyd is sufficient and able to be certified
- Councilmember Boyd has five (5) days after the City
 Secretary officially certifies the recall petition to resign (Sunday, September 22, 2024)
- □ If the Councilmember does not resign within the timeframe, the City Council shall order and fix a date for holding a recall election on the first authorized uniform election date (Saturday, May 3, 2025)
