ROOF REPLACEMENT AT KILLEEN UTILITY COLLECTIONS BUILDING

Background

- The roof at Utilities Collections building is 20+ years old, has several leaks and repair costs have increased
- Water penetrations present air quality issues and to prevent any structural damage to the building, replacement of the roof needs to occur
- Replacing the roof will decrease maintenance costs, prevent air quality issues, and prevent structural damage going forward

- Through approved purchasing cooperatives, City obtained a bid proposal for the replacement of the Utility Collections building roof from Final Solutions Roofing, LLC for \$85,956.22
- 50 mil Duro-Last PVC membrane
- 20-year roof system warranty

Alternatives

- Do not replace the deteriorating roof at the Killeen Utility
 Collections building
- Replace the roof at Killeen Utility Collections building

City Council authorize the acceptance of the bid proposal from Final Solutions Roofing, LLC (TIPS Vendor #181101) in the amount not to exceed \$85,956.22 and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute contract and any change orders allowed by state and local law.
