BELL COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH

- FY 2025 City of Killen contribution \$345,513.22
 - Helps cover Environmental Health salaries and 25% of their benefits
- Next steps
 - Countywide Community Health Assessment
 - Focus Groups (community partners and residents)
 - Launch of PrEP in June 2024
 - Rewriting the BCPH Cooperative Agreement
 - Will include review and revision of funding from municipalities to align with the state statute
