- Action Priorities
 - The City of Killeen will:
 - Seek full reimbursement from the State of Texas for lost revenue due to state-granted veterans exemptions
 - Oppose any extension of state-granted veterans exemptions that is not fully funded by the State of Texas
 - Seek legislative action to allow Killeen municipal elections in November

Current Legislative Priorities and Principles

- Guiding Principles
 - The City of Killeen supports legislation that would:
 - Provide benefit to military communities
 - Provide local relief for impacts of state-granted exemptions and programs
 - Provide transportation funding for local projects
 - Provide funding for local park, trail, or public grounds projects
 - Be beneficial to Texas A&M University-Central Texas, Central Texas College and/or Killeen Independent School District

Current Legislative Priorities and Principles

- Guiding Principles
 - The City of Killeen opposes legislation that would:
 - Remove or limit local control or preempt local authority
 - Be detrimental to current or potential City revenue
 - Impose partially or fully unfunded mandates
 - Erode zoning authority
 - Be detrimental to local economic development efforts
 - Create an adverse impact by imposing environmental or water restrictions or regulations
