

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH OMNIA PARTNERS PURCHASING COOPERATIVE

Background

- Killeen entered into an interlocal agreement with The Cooperative Purchasing Network (TCPN) in August 2013
- TCPN and US Communities purchasing cooperative merged to form OMNIA Partners in December 2018
- City used multiple vendors with TCPN over the past 3 years totaling:
 - □ 2017 \$2.1 million
 - □ 2018 \$2.1 million
 - □ 2019 \$3.4 million

Background continued

- An interlocal agreement with OMNIA Partners is necessary for continued access to the more than 300 contracts
 - Information Technology, fleet, public safety, more
- There is no cost to join OMNIA Partners purchasing cooperative
- Purchasing from a cooperative complies with the Local Government Code and City policy

- Do not approve the interlocal agreement with OMNIA Partners purchasing cooperative
- Approve the interlocal agreement with OMNIA
 Partners purchasing cooperative

Recommendation

City Council approve the interlocal agreement with OMNIA Partners purchasing cooperative and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute the interlocal agreement and any supplemental agreement as allowed by state and local law
