- □ On June 4, 2023, the City was made aware of a force main sewer line break at Lift Station No. 20.
 - The main break was at 16' depth, which staff was not equipped to reach.
- Staff arrived on scene and shut down the lift station in order to repair the leak.
- □ Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) was notified and on location assisting with testing.

- □ There were many departments and contractors involved in the emergency remediation efforts:
 - City of Killeen (Water & Sewer, Mowing & Drainage, Emergency Management, and Storm Water Team)
 - S & M Vacuum and Waste LTD
 - TTG Utilities
 - Ramm's Pump & Water Well Service
 - Bio Chem Lab, Inc.
 - TCEQ
 - Bell County Emergency Management Coordinator

- On June 7, 2023, repairs were completed and Lift Station No. 20, along with the entire sewer collection system was back to normal operations.
- On July 5, 2023, TCEQ sent in confirmation that the City was able to cease the bacteria and dissolved oxygen testing monitoring.
- □ Remediation efforts were completed in the sum of \$72,799.
