- Leading up to the FY 2025 budget, one of the Mayor's priorities was to focus more on the overall cleanliness of the city.
- On September 3, 2024, City Council approved the FY 2025 budget; which included a Litter Crew, comprised of three (3) full time employees.
- This litter crew is dedicated to removing trash from highly visible roadways, homeless cleanups, illegal dumping and ensuring downtown is clear of trash and debris for any upcoming events.
