Background

- Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (KFHRA) was readmitted to Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Military Airport Program (MAP) in 2018 for a five (5) year period
- The FAA offered KFHRA a MAP grant in the amount of \$276,620 for the construction and \$500 for advertising, totaling \$277,120, to fund the Rehabilitation of the Airport Parking Lot

Background

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- The project includes minor pavement repairs, slurry seal and remarking
- The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) signed into law on March 11, 2021 increases the federal share to 100 percent
- No impact to the Airport Operating fund

Alternatives

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- Do not accept the grant
- Accept the grant

Recommendation

- City Council accept the Federal Aviation Administration MAP grant in the amount of \$277,120 and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all grant documents and any and all amendments or actions within the amounts set by federal, state and local law
