

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS TO DISANNEX APPROXIMATELY 11.98 ACRES OUT OF THE W. H. BRUCE SURVEY, ABSTRACT 1296, BEING GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF F.M. 2484, WEST OF THE INTERSECTION WITH TRES JACK ROAD; DECLARING SAID LAND TO NO LONGER BE A PART OF SAID CITY; DECLARING SAID LAND AND PRESENT AND FUTURE INHABITANTS OF SAID LAND TO NOT BE ENTITLED TO ANY OF THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF CITIZENS OF THE CITY AND TO NOT BE BOUND BY THE ACTS AND ORDINANCES OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Bill A. Dean presented to the City of Killeen a request for disannexation of approximately 11.98 acres out of the W. H. Bruce Survey, Abstract 1296, generally located on the south side of F.M. 2484, west of the intersection with Tres Jack Road, and locally addressed as 13451 F.M. 2484, Salado, Texas;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Killeen, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 43.142 is authorized to disannex an area in the municipality according to rules as may be provided by the charter of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Killeen, pursuant to its Home Rule Charter, Section 7, is authorized to fix the boundaries of Killeen and relinquish territory of the City of Killeen.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS:**

**SECTION I:** That on and after the date of passage of this ordinance, the City of Killeen grants the petition for disannexation, and the City Limits of the City of Killeen, Texas shall be and are hereby amended to relinquish approximately 11.98 acres out of the W. H. Bruce Survey, Abstract 1296. The property is generally located on the south side of F.M.

2484, west of the intersection with Tres Jack Road, and locally addressed as 13451 F.M. 2484, Salado, Texas.

**SECTION II:** It is declared that the land hereby disannexed and described in Section I hereof is not and shall hereafter no longer be a part of the City of Killeen, Bell County, Texas, and it is hereby further declared that said land and the present and future inhabitants thereof are hereafter not entitled to any of the rights and privileges of citizens of the City of Killeen and shall not be bound by the acts and ordinances of the City of Killeen, Texas.

**SECTION III:** That should any section or part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, it shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or parts of this ordinance.

**SECTION IV:** That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION V.** That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Killeen, Texas, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

**SECTION VI:** That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage of the ordinance.
