PURCHASE OF ADDITIONAL ELECTION EQUIPMENT

June 18, 2024

- A general election is held each May to elect City Council
- Election equipment was initially purchased in 2019 from Election Systems and Software (ES&S)
- Digitizing the election process (thermal ballots & electronic voter check in) the past several years has required additional equipment be rented from Bell County

Purchase of Additional Election Equipment

- Procurement of additional election equipment will allow the City to be self-sufficient in future elections
- □ \$76,000 was allocated in the FY2024 mid-year budget amendment to purchase the equipment
- Annual post-warranty license and maintenance and support fees for the additional equipment is \$6,980
- ES&S is a member of the Texas Buyboard Purchasing Cooperative, and the additional purchase follows state and local law purchasing requirements

- Equipment, software and services to be purchased:
 - Eight (8) additional ExpressVote machines with carrying cases
 - Twenty-two (22) new ExpressPollbook (ePollbook) machines with printers and carrying cases
 - Machine memory devices and thumb drives
 - ExpressPollbook licensing and training

Staff recommends City Council approve the purchase of additional election equipment from Election Systems and Software in the amount of \$76,000, and that the City Manager or his designee to execute any and all change orders in accordance with state law
