Background

- The Aquatics Division of Parks and Recreation is aiming to renew a partnership with the Armed Services Young Men's Christian Association (ASYMCA) for the shared use of facilities.
- The existing agreement is scheduled to expire on May 31, 2026. The new agreement will retain the same terms as the current one.
- By collaborating on facilities, the Aquatics Division and ASYMCA have greatly expanded their combined reach and influence.

Background

- The Natatorium will be available to the City at no cost for five months, from December to April, during the Winter and Spring Aquatic Program seasons. This includes access to one room for hiring, interviewing, and conferencing during the same period.
- The Multi-purpose fields at Lions Club Park will be available at no cost for four months, from April to May and September to October, for ASYMC flag football and/or soccer programs.
