AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KILLEEN, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 4, 2024 FOR THE ELECTION OF A MAYOR AND THREE COUNCILMEMBERS-AT-LARGE
