

TIRZ #2 ORDINANCE UPDATE

Background

- On December 13, 2022, Council adopted an ordinance amending the boundary of the TIRZ #2 to include an additional 332 acres on the east side of N. Roy Reynolds Drive for expansion of the Killeen Business Park.
- At that time, the duration of the TIRZ #2 was extended by 20 years to expire in 2048, and the Project and Financing Plan was amended.

Proposed Amendment

- The adopted ordinance includes the tax rate for each of the taxing units within the zone (City of Killeen, Bell County, and Central Texas College).
- □ The tax rate for Bell County referenced in the ordinance (\$0.3626) inadvertently included the Road and Bridge District tax.
- □ The correct Bell County tax rate is \$0.3160.

Proposed Amendment

□ Therefore, staff is proposing to amend the ordinance as follows:

Taxing Unit	Dedicated Tax Rate	% of Total Participation
City of Killeen	\$0.6233	100%
Bell County	\$0.3626 <u>\$0.3160</u>	100%
Central Texas College	\$0.0960	100%
TOTAL	\$1.0353/\$100 valuation	100%
