AWARD OF CONTRACT-HANGAR DOOR REPLACEMENT AT SKYLARK FIELD AIRPORT

Background

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- Door replacement for City owned commercial hangar at Skylark Field
- □ Current doors are over 35 years old
- After multiple repairs over the last few years they can no longer be effectively repaired
- Safety hazard to tenants and aircraft

Background

The project consists of replacing the current doors with new horizontal sliding doors and replacing all structural steel and any other items required for this new door to operate per manufacturers specifications and meet all safety, building code, and engineering requirements

Background

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- Project has been advertised on two other occasions. The first time the bids came in over the funding available. The project was later rebid with additional funding; however, there were no bids received.
- The project was rebid a third time and advertised beginning on April 2, 2023. Advertising appeared in the local Newspaper as well as the City's website. Additionally, it was advertised on multiple statewide electronic bidding sites.

□ Bids were opened on April 26, 2023 - Two (2) bids received

Staff reviewed bid packages and found NNAC Inc. to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder

Discussion

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- NNAC was the contractor for previous hangars that were constructed at Skylark Field.
 - Includes Base Bid and 3 Additive Alternates
 - The contract amount is \$110,340.34
 - Project is funded by a TxDOT Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) Grant in the amount of \$50,000 and remainder of the funding will come from the Aviation Operating Fund
