ELECTRICAL SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR FIRE STATION #4/EOC

Background

- FY 2022 Capital Improvement Plan included the EOC project as funded with \$11.9M in ARPA funding
- On May 3, 2022, council approved the use of the FY2021 excess balance of the General Fund allowing construction of a new Fire Station #4.
- On February 20, 2024, the City Council approved the award of construction contract with Cerris Builders (formally MW Builders) for the construction of the EOC/FS#4 Complex.

Background

- As part of the construction, utility services are constructed and connected to the facilities. Bartlett Cooperative Inc, provides the electrical service in this area.
- The agreement includes the initial \$38,123.63 for the construction and supply of the transformer, and electrical service to the meter. The agreement also specifies the minimum monthly bill payment for the term of the agreement.
