- Instances of downtime due to equipment failure pose a significant risk to the safety and security of the premises, potentially leaving vulnerabilities unmonitored
- Replacing the outdated cameras with modern, dependable models is imperative to ensure continuous and uninterrupted surveillance coverage

- Upgrading the security cameras is essential to enhance the overall safety and security of the court facility
- Advanced camera technology offers features such as higher resolution, wider coverage angles, and improved night vision capabilities
- In addition to upgrading the cameras, it is imperative to address the aging recording server infrastructure. The outdated recording server has storage capacity limitations, reduced reliability, and compatibility issues with modern camera systems
