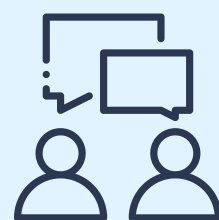

## Forensic Interviews

**699**

Fact-finding interviews conducted by a trained professional and designed to minimize the number of times a child must tell their story.



## Medical Examinations

**230**

Specialized medical assessments and treatment to child abuse victims. Provided by Baylor Scott & White McLane Children's Pediatric Forensic Medicine Program.



## Family Advocacy

**2,463**

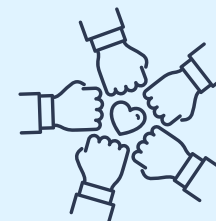
Offers child victims and non-offending caregivers the support, education, and resources needed to overcome the trauma of abuse.



## Mental Health Sessions

**2,221**

Evidence-based, trauma-informed interventions that allow child victims the chance to heal from abuse.



## Case Coordinations

**1,992**

A multi-disciplinary team (MDT) approach to investigations of child abuse ensures that the well-being of the child is the utmost importance.



## Intake Reviews

**7,845**

Reviewing DFPS Statewide Intakes to assess all reports of abuse to coordinate appropriate referrals for services.
