ORDINANCE AMENDING WATER & SEWER RATES

September 6, 2022

Background

- On July 7, 2020, City Council received the results of the 2020 Water & Sewer Rate Study indicating that water revenues were insufficient to fully fund projected expenses.
 - City Council deferred a rate adjustment in FY 2021 due to Covid.
- On September 14, 2021, Council approved a rate adjustment for residential and commercial customers.

Background Cont.

- The 2020 Water & Sewer Rate Study also recommended that there be a five-year phased meter charge increase for commercial water service; which is an American Water Works Association (AWWA) standard, to prevent one large increase.
 - This was suggested to begin in FY 2024.
- Beginning the five-year phased commercial rate increase in FY 2023 would assist to offset the insufficient revenue for water and the annual increase from WCID.
 - □ This will affect commercial customers (in-city and out-of-city).
 - Increase will provide an estimated \$158,000 in revenue.
