# Background and Discussion

2

- The City of Killeen and KISD will both hold elections on *May 5th*
- School districts are required to hold joint elections with city or county (EC 11.0581)
- State law requires a joint election agreement laying out each entity's responsibility and costs
- Separate agreements for early voting and election day.

# Benefits

3

- Voter convenience—voters cast ballots for both elections at one location; and
- Reduces the election costs for each entity

# Fiscal Impact

4

- Election expenses initially paid by the city
- KISD will reimburse the city for  $\frac{1}{2}$  of shared election costs
- Total election cost will be approximately \$50,000, and the city's portion has been budgeted



# Recommendation

5

- Staff recommends City Council approve the Early Voting and Election Day joint election agreements with KISD and authorize the City Manager to enter into the agreements.
