Background

- The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Military Airport Program (MAP) is a program available to civil airport sponsors of Joint-Use Military Airfield or former military airfields to assist in the transition from a military airfield to a civilian airport.
- FAA has offered the City a MAP Grant in an amount up to \$4,553,070 to fund a portion of the new corporate hangar at the Killeen-Fort Hood Regional Airport (KFHRA).

Discussion

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- Some components of this project are not eligible for FAA funding.
 - ▣ Site/Civil Improvements (eligible)
 - ▣ Construct new 8,000 sq. ft. hangar (eligible)
 - ▣ Construction administration and oversight services (eligible)
 - ▣ Interior framing and finish out of 2,000 sq. ft. office space (ineligible)

Discussion

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- Total project cost is estimated to be \$5,741,967
 - ▣ \$4,553,070 federally funded portion
 - ▣ \$1,188,897 from Aviation funds for the match and ineligible portions
- This project would provide additional revenues to the Aviation fund as well as provide economic development opportunities for the City.

Alternatives

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- Do not accept the grant
- Accept the grant

Recommendation

- City Council accept the Federal Aviation Administration MAP Grant up to the amount of \$4,553,070 and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all grant documents and any and all amendments or actions within the amounts set by federal, state and local law
