

RESOLUTION FOR CTCOG HHW FY 2025

- Each year Central Texas Council of Governments (CTCOG) accepts a Call for Projects to assist with funding of events or projects that are open to all counties within the CTCOG region.
- The City of Killeen annually request grant funding from the CTCOG for our annual Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Event.
 - □ Grants have ranged from \$10,000 \$20,000 annually

- Beginning with the FY 2025 Call for Projects, Texas Commission of Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has added a requirement to the submission packet; a "Resolution" granting permission for our city representative to submit and accept funding for the submission.
- This request has no financial responsibility on the City and any grant funds received will be brought before Council by means of an Interlocal Agreement.

- Do not approve the resolution; City of Killeen will fund the entirety of the FY 2025 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Event and host only Killeen residents.
- Approve the resolution; allowing the Solid Waste Recycling Manager to submit for and accept grant funds from the CTCOG to host a Household Hazardous Event in FY 2025.

Recommendation

□ City Council authorize the Mayor to sign a resolution allowing the Solid Waste Recycling Manager to request and accept grant funds from the Central Texas Council of Governments to host a regional household hazardous waste event in FY 2025 that will be open to all seven (7) counties.
