TXDOT IDM STEP Grant for FY 2023

- The Police Department has applied for and been awarded an Impaired Driving Mobilization (IDM) grant for the purpose of traffic safety, and it was approved by the Texas Department of Transportation.
- The goal of the grant is to reduce the number of DWI related crashes, injuries, and fatalities.
- This grant will provide funding in the amount of \$21,241.09 that will be utilized for overtime to promote traffic safety to reduce crashes and make the City of Killeen roads safer.

Funding

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager or his designee to accept the 2023 TXDOT IDM STEP grant and enter into the grant agreement. Staff also recommends that the Police Department be authorized to administer the duties required for the grant with the oversight of the City's Finance Department. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the City agrees to return all funds to the Texas Department of Transportation.
