

APPROVAL FOR CENTRAL SQUARE SOFTWARE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

Background

- The City utilizes Central Square's Naviline software for its current Financial, Human Resources, Payroll, and Utility Billing modules
- While the city transitions to its new ERP, maintenance and support on the existing software needs to be maintained
- The annual software maintenance covers extended software support, upgrades, and software releases until the new modules are configured in OpenGov and UKG

Background continued

- As new modules are completed, the annual maintenance cost is expected to decrease, and we can choose not to renew when the ERP is implemented
- The Information Technology department expects the OpenGov and UKG modules to be completed as follows:
 - Financial phase I September 2024
 - Financial phase II January 2025
 - HR/Payroll February 2025
 - Utility Collections is currently going through the RFP process with an anticipated completion date of October 2025

Recommendation

□ City staff recommends that the City Council approve the renewal of a maintenance agreement with Central Square, for three years, in an amount of \$620,123, and that the City Manager or designee be expressly authorized to execute any and all change orders within the amounts set by state and local law
