Background

- In December 2024, the Information Technology department published a Request for Proposals (RFP) to provide EOC audiovisual equipment and received four responses
- An evaluation team consisting of staff from the Finance, Information Technology, Emergency Operations, and Fire Departments evaluated the four proposals
- Of those four, GTS/Uplink was selected as the vendor that had the best qualifications and fully met the City's operational, technological, and fiscal requirements

Background

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- The new Emergency Operation Center audio-visual system will have the ability to:
 - Display information across a seamless video wall consisting of multi-view commercial-grade displays
 - Display and integration to training and conference rooms
 - Integrate with the Real Time Crime Center
 - Conference using webcam, ceiling mounted speakers, and an array of microphones
 - Wireless presentation gateway to facilitate Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) screen sharing

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Manager, or his designee be authorized to execute a Professional Service agreement with GTS/Uplink for in the installation of Audio/Visual Equipment for the new EOC in the amount of \$895,350 utilizing the DIR-CPO-4754 contract and authorize the City Manager, or designee, be expressly authorized to execute any and all change orders set within the amounts set by state and local law.
