SUMMER LEARNING CREDIT RECOVERY PROGRAM

PROMOTION

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Students are provided an opportunity to earn promotion if they have failed no more than 2 core classes during the regular school year. Core classes include reading/language arts, math, science, and social studies. Students who fail 3 or more courses may attend summer school but will not qualify to seek promotion through summer school.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

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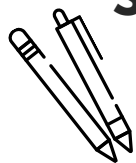
Special Education personnel will be available to follow a student's IEP in the area needed for credit recovery.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNER (ELL) OPPORTUNITY

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Students who actively participated in English Language Learning during the 21-22 school year at their home campus may enroll in the English Language Learner program to continue the learning of English.

Students will receive an invitation to summer learning if they qualify through the ELL program.

PARENT CONFERENCE

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Your child's teacher will contact you with a specific time. Parents of retained students must attend a parent-teacher conference prior to the conclusion of summer learning.



STUDENT ID

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All Middle School Summer Learning students must wear their school ID. If students lost their school ID, they need to purchase a new one for summer school.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Attendance



After the second absence, students will be withdrawn from the summer learning program, and the opportunity to earn promotion through summer learning will be forfeited (in compliance with TEC Code 25.092).

Students arriving after 7:40 a.m. will be counted tardy.

Behavior



Students may be dropped from summer learning for violation of the Student Code of Conduct. If a student is dropped, he/she will not be able to earn promotion through summer learning to the next grade level.

School Nutrition



Students may choose to eat a nutritionally balanced breakfast and lunch free of charge.

Transportation



Transportation is provided from the students' home campus to the summer learning campus. Students must have a school ID to ride. Check bus schedules at registration for specific arrival and departure times from the home campus.
