BELL COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH

- Bell County Public Health Core Areas:
 - Environmental Health (OSSF, Retail Food, Vector)
 - Clinical Services & Systems (Immunizations, STDs, TB, Hepatitis B)
 - Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
 - Community Health
 - Public Health Emergency Preparedness
 - Epidemiology
 - Public Health Administration





BELL COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH

- FY2025 City of Killeen contribution \$345,513.22
 - Helps cover Environmental Health salaries and 25% of their benefits

- FY2026 City of Killeen contribution \$341,607.88
 - Helps cover Environmental Health salaries and 25% of their benefits





BELL COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH

- Next steps
 - Refocusing Clinical Services to Immunizations, STDs, and TB
 - Increasing focus on Public Health Emergency Preparedness
 - Rewriting the BCPH Cooperative Agreement
 - Has not been revised since 1994
 - Will include review and revision of funding from municipalities to align with the state statute Chapter 121 of the Texas Health and Safety Code
 - Will include alignment with national standards for Public Health Governance
- Identifying additional funding sources due to impact of federal funding elimination
