Background and Best Practices

- The City's current agreement for liability, property, and workers' compensation insurance services became effective on October 1, 2016.
 - Current agreement holder = Texas Municipal League – Intergovernmental Risk Pool (TML-IRP)
- To ensure best value and coverage, staff utilized the RFP process to bid for these insurance services.
- Going forward the City will bid these services at minimum every 5 years to ensure market competitiveness

RFP Requirements and Responses

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- The City sought bids including but not limited to the following lines of coverage and services:
 - ▣ Coverages = workers' compensation, liability, auto liability and physical damage, real and personal property, and cyber liability
 - ▣ Services = compliance, legal consulting, loss prevention, claims administration, and training
- The City received responses from 1 vendor; TML-IRP

Staff Recommendation

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Staff recommends the City Council approve the City to enter into a contract with TML-IRP as the continued provider of the aforementioned lines of insurance in the estimated amount of \$3,100,016 effective October 1, 2026, and that the City Manager or designee is further authorized to execute any necessary change orders in accordance with state and local law.
