Interlocal Agreement with Juvenile Services

- This interlocal agreement creates a collaboration between the Killeen Police Department and Bell County Juvenile Services.
- KPD will partner with Juvenile Probation Officers, accompanying them for home visits with juvenile probationers.
- This is a valuable opportunity for KPD officers to engage directly with juvenile probationers and their families.

Interlocal Agreement with Juvenile Services

□ Benefits:

- KPD Officers will acquire a deeper understanding of how to recommend or provide services, while fostering positive relationships with probationers beyond traditional law enforcement interactions.
- Bell County Juvenile Probation Officers will benefit from the added security provided by the presence of KPD Officers assigned to the program.

Funding

- BCJS will reimburse the city up to \$60 per hour for salary and benefits for officers working on the project.
- Estimated FY25 revenue from reimbursement is \$7500.
- Projected revenue will be included in a future budget amendment.

Recommendation

- Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the City Manager or his designee to enter into an interlocal agreement with Bell County Juvenile Services to allow KPD Officers to assist Bell County Juvenile Probation Officers with home visits with juvenile probationers.
