

APPROVING AN MOA WITH ASYMCA FOR JOINT USE OF FACILITIES

Background

- The Aquatics Division of Parks and Recreation aims to establish a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Armed Services Young Men's Christian Association (ASYMCA) for shared facility use over the next year.
- Additionally, this partnership will enable the Athletics and Aquatics Division of Parks and Recreation to conduct lifeguard interviews and swimming qualification assessments at the Natatorium, while also exploring and developing new opportunities for collaborative programming.

Background

- The Natatorium will be available to the City at no cost for five months, from December to April, during the Winter and Spring Aquatic Program seasons. This includes access to one room for hiring, interviewing, and conferencing during the same period.
- The Multi-purpose fields at Lions Club Park will be available at no cost for four months, from April to May and September to October, for ASYMC flag football and/or soccer programs.

 Staff recommends that City Council approve the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Armed Services Young Men's Christian Association for the joint use of facilities.
