
PETITION FOR RELEASE FROM CITY OF KILLEEN ETJ

- On September 26, 2025, staff received a petition for release from the ETJ from WBW Development for portions of two parcels located in the ETJ (Parcel IDs #526071 and 26812).
- □ The subject properties are generally located south of Chaparral Road and east of East Trimmier Road.



Background


□ Texas Local Government Code Sec. 42.104(d) states: "If a municipality fails to take action to release the area [...] by the later of the 45^{th} day after the date the municipality receives the petition or the next meeting of the municipality's governing body that occurs after the 30th day after the date the municipality receives the petition, the area is released by operation of law.

- However, Texas Local Government Code Sec. 42.101(1) also states: "This subchapter does not apply to an area located within five miles of the boundary of a military base, as defined by Sec. 43.0117, at which an active training program is conducted."
- Per Texas Local Government Code Sec. 43.0117(a), "military base" means "a presently functioning federally owned or operated military installation or facility."


Fort Hood Official Boundary




According to Fort Hood, the official boundary of the military base includes portions of the right-of-way along S.H. 201 (Clear Creek Road) and S.H. 195 (South Fort Hood Street).



Request for Release from the ETJ



The applicant has submitted a request to release from the ETJ those portions of their property that are located more than 5-miles from the western edge of the Texas State Veterans Cemetery.




Recommendation
