- Department of State Health Services conducts inspections annually
- Condition of the building has been cited on inspections in the past several years
- Department of State Health Services could close the facility and halt operations if the condition is not addressed
- Existing building was constructed in 1970's, has been repaired multiple times, and needs to be replaced
- □ New quarantine building in FY 23 CIP for a total of \$1,840,000
 - \$240,000 in FY23 for design and \$850,000 for construction
 - Planned for a bond issue at the end of FY23
 - \$375,000 in FY24 and FY25 from Fort Hood IGSA

- City was contacted by the owner of East Lake Veterinary Clinic to see if the City would be interested in purchasing
- The East Lake facility offers improved kennels, enhanced amenities, and accommodations that would enhance our customer experience
- If approved, the East Lake location would be used for pet adoptions
 - Current adoption facilities would be used as quarantine facilities
- New facility would allow us to expand upon our spay/neuter capabilities with in-house operating room


