2024 Jag Grant Acceptance

- The Killeen Police Department has successfully applied for and received the 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) in the amount of \$85,235.00.
- Annually, the City of Killeen collaborates with Bell County and the City of Temple through an Interlocal Agreement to share the grant funds.
- As per the agreement, the City of Killeen is responsible for managing the funds, which includes distributing them, overseeing compliance, submitting performance reports and assessment data, and offering continuous support to sub-recipients.

Funding

□ Total Jag Award: \$85,234

□ City of Killeen: \$43,043

□ City of Temple \$19,178

□ County of Bell \$23,013

KPD anticipates utilizing these funds towards the purchase of equipment to enhance our ability to respond to emergency events.

There are no matching funds requirement for this grant.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the acceptance of the 2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant through the Killeen Police Department on behalf of all involved parties. Additionally, it is recommended that the City Manager, or their designee, be authorized to sign the Interlocal Agreement, and that the Killeen Police Department be permitted to allocate and manage the grant responsibilities under the supervision of the City's Finance Department.
