

INCREASE FOR PURCHASE OF LIBRARY BOOKS THROUGH TXSMARTBUY CONTRACT

- In December 2023, Council approved a TXSMARTBUY contract with Ingram Library Services for the purchase of library materials, in an amount not to exceed\$90,000.
- In May 2024, Library Services canceled the \$42,785 lease for library materials from Baker & Taylor due to poor fulfillment rates.
 - Funds for leasing were transferred to the appropriate account for the purchase of library materials.

- Staff recommends that the transferred funds be used to increase the TXSMARTBUY contract purchase limit in an amount not to exceed \$132,785 for the purchase additional library materials from Ingram Library Services.
- Increasing purchase limit will allow the library maintain state accreditation.
