2

- Consists of
 - ▣ Interlocal Agreement
- Vocational program for junior and senior years
- Allows KISD students the opportunity to become certified Firefighters straight out of high school
 - ▣ Texas Commission on Fire Protection – Basic Firefighter
 - ▣ Texas Department of Health – Emergency Medical Technician

Interlocal Agreement Renewal – Killeen I.S.D. and Killeen Fire Department

- Intrinsic value
 - ▣ KISD demographic adds to diversity of KFD
 - ▣ Hires more local residents
- Conforms to city policy and state laws
- Alternatives:
 - ▣ Not entering into the agreement results in no career path into the fire service directly
 - ▣ Entering into agreement creates cooperation between KFD and KISD which enables a career path into fire service

Interlocal Agreement Renewal – Killeen I.S.D. and Killeen Fire Department

- Financial impact
 - ▣ KISD will pay a minimum \$61,000 up to \$96,350 for maximum enrollment annually for two classes – junior and seniors
 - ▣ \$30,865 per annum is the cost associated to operate this program, this is a portion of the salary of currently employed instructors.
- Staff recommends approval of renewal of Interlocal Agreement for fire academy
