

LOA FOR THREE (3) PUMPS AT PUMP STATION #4

Background and Findings

- Pump Station #4 was built in 1986 with two (2) pumps and is one of two pump stations that provides potable drinking water for Killeen's Upper Pressure Plane.
- In 1995, two (2) additional pumps as part of a planned site expansion to provide additional pumping capacity to the Upper Pressure Plane with the construction of the first ground storage tank at McMillan Mountain.
- This site pumps an average of 50 MG per month into two
 (2) 1.5 MG ground storage tanks located on McMillan Mountain, east of Bunny Trail.

- □ Throughout the life of each pump, repairs have been made to continue utilizing them, as these pumps have a life expectancy of 10 20 years.
- □ A quote was received from Austin Armature Works, LP on BuyBoard contract #672-22 to provide and install three (3) pumps at Pump Station #4 in the amount of \$114,968.
