## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) INSPECTION, CLEANING, AND REPAIR

- □ The Killeen Fire Department provides Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for our firefighters. (coat, trousers, boots, helmets, & gloves)
- National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Standard 1851 requires Advanced Cleaning twice annually and an Advanced Inspection of all PPE once annually, or when a Routine Inspection determines potential damage.
- These services are required to be provided by the original manufacturer, a verified independent service provider, or a trained and certified member of the department.

## Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Inspection, Cleaning, and Repair

- □ Lion First Responders PPE, Inc. is the original manufacturer of our current PPE through.
- □ Lion Total Care is a subsidiary of Lion First Responder PPE, Incard and is trained and certified to provide the required services.
- Lion Total Care will provide Advanced Inspections, Advanced Cleaning, and Repairs as necessary through Lion First Responder PPE, Inc. Sourcewell contract # 010424.

## Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Inspection, Cleaning, and Repair

Staff recommends that the City Manager or his designee be authorized to utilize Lion Total Care in an amount not to exceed \$107,390, to Inspect, Clean, and Repair PPE through Lion First Responders PPE, Inc. Sourcewell Cooperative Contract #010424, and that the City Manager or designee is expressly authorized to execute any, and all change orders within the amounts set by state and local law.
