



RESTATED AND AMENDED WCID #1 AGREEMENT ADDENDUM NO. 1

Background

- In 1968, the City of Killeen (COK) entered into a Waste Disposal Contract with Bell County Water Control and Improvement District No. #1 (WCID) for the treatment of the City's wastewater.
 - Over the years, this contract has been amended for various reasons, with the most recent amendment approved by the City Council on September 12, 2023, and effective as of December 14, 2023.
- On November 5, 2024, the Council received a tour of the 38th Street Wastewater Plant, where upcoming improvements to enhance water quality, reliability, and safety were discussed. Completion is expected by the end of 2026.

Background

- Addendum No. 1 modifies the Restated and Amended Waste Disposal Contract, specifically for Section 22, dated December 14, 2023.
- WCID and the City have agreed to present Addendum No. 1 to address the allocation of Debt Service for the Bell County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 Sanitary Sewer System Revenue Bonds, Series 2025, for Plant 1 modifications at the 38th Street Treatment Facility.
 - The City's share of the project to not exceed \$14,870,000.
 - The City is responsible for 100% of the debt service associated with these bonds.
