
## Background

- Several Parks and Recreation Projects were funded through the ARPA money provided to the City of Killeen.
- Allocated ARPA funds will be used to design and construct sidewalks and trails for Phyllis Park, Conder Park, Stewart Park, and the West side of Long Branch Park.
- Parks and Recreation staff is seeking approval for a BuyBoard cooperative agreement with Heartland Parks and Recreation, LLC. in an amount not to exceed \$1,172,771.


## Background

- If approved, Heartland Parks and Recreation, LLC will take approximately 45 days for site analysis and design, and all trail work will be complete 90 days from start of construction.
- This project will provide a place where people can be physically active to reduce stress, give more access to green environments, and provide a safe, accessible place for people to walk, bike, wheelchair roll, and do other physical activities.


