

ILA AMENDMENT #1 WITH CTCOG FOR HHW EVENT

- On March 26, 2024, City Council approved CCM/R 24-58R; Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Central Texas Council of Governments (CTCOG) to receive \$20,000 in funding towards the city's Household Hazardous Waste (HHW).
 - □ City's portion not to exceed \$45,000.
- □ The HHW event took place on Saturday, May 4, 2024, with 595 vehicles attending. This was the largest HHW event since June 2020.


Background Cont.

- □ Due to the success of the event, the total amount due from the city for disposal is \$55,369.75.
 - Funds are available in the FY 2024 approved budget.

Household Hazardous Waste Event

City of Killeen 2024 HHW Event

- 595 cars total
- Residents from 3 counties
 attended the event
- 57% of attendee new
- 76% of attendees from Killeen and Haker Heights
- Paint, Chemicals, and
 Oil/antifreeze were the most
 common items dropped off
- 19% of attendees brought
 batteries and/or fluorescent bulbs



Recommendation

□ City Council authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute Amendment #1 to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Killeen and the Central Texas Council of Governments (CTCOG) for an additional \$10,369.75 to cover the amount for disposal at the HHW event that took place May 6, 2024.
