Background and Findings

- □ Pumps have a life cycle of 10 20 years, are made up of many parts and are critical to the water/wastewater infrastructure system to move fluids from one location to another.
- Staff went out for a multi-year bid for motor replacements within four (4) pump stations that have all exceeded their life cycle.
- On February 5, 2025, Purchasing received one (1) response for bid 25-19, Motor Replacements.

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- Review of the one (1) response showed that specifications in the bid packet were not quoted as specified.
- General instructions and preparations of the bid conditions within the bid documents allow the city to reject any and all bids.
