Problem/Issue/Idea Name for Agenda:

Lack of Informative Signage

Description of Problem/Issue/Idea:

There are 3 “gateways” into the City of Killeen. The City currently has one (1) welcome sign located at its south entrance, alongside Highway 195. A welcome sign no longer exists at the east entrance alongside Interstate 14, nor has a welcome sign been re-established at the west entrance. Additionally, citizens are regularly unaware of whom their local government representatives are as well as councilmember Districts. The City also lacks dedicated electronic signage to communicate events, closures, news, alerts, election information, etc.

Requested Action:

Consider establishing welcome signs along Interstate 14 at both east and west entrances. Consider establishing 2 to 4 road signs displaying councilmember names/designation at strategic locations in Killeen. Consider establishing a limited number of Councilmember district boundary signs in strategic locations. Consider establishing dedicated electronic signage to communicate pertinent City information.
