Background

- The United States (U.S.) Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) began the Partnership for Your Success (PaYS)
 Program in October 2000 as an enlistment incentive.
- The PaYS program is a strategic partnership between the U.S. Army and a cross-section of corporations, companies, and public sector agencies.
- The PaYS program connects enlisting Soldiers and Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) Cadets to corporations, companies, and public sector agencies for guaranteed interviews and possible employment after the Army.

Benefits to The City of Killeen

- No financial obligation and no obligation to hold positions for candidates in the PaYS program.
- TRADOC has invited the City of Killeen to participate in the PaYS program, offering soldiers and cadets interviews for City of Killeen positions, where they're qualified. This does not guarantee employment and applicants must meet the minimum qualifications to be eligible to interview.
- Participation in the program will benefit the City of Killeen by expanding the applicant pool for vacancies, attracting individuals who safeguard America as well as provide a stronger American workforce both today and in the future.

Benefits to The City of Killeen (Cont.)

- The City of Killeen will potentially employ professional, trained, and responsible men and women with Army values, experience, and proven leadership skills.
- The City of Killeen will work side-by-side with Army Recruiters at career fairs or jointly staffed booths, sending a powerful message throughout the community.
- The Program is available to men and women in the Regular U.S. Army, U.S. Army National Guard, and U.S. Army Reserve.
