MICROSOFT ENTERPRISE LICENSE AGREEMENT (EA)

Background

- For the past 3 years, the City of Killeen has utilized and purchased Microsoft products through an Enterprise Agreement (EA) which will expire September 30, 2022
- Microsoft Enterprise Agreements allows for, or include:
 - Volume pricing
 - Flexible license management
 - Software updates
 - Access to the most current, updated versions, of products like
 Windows, Office 365, One Drive, SharePoint, Teams and Outlook

- All City workstations and most City servers are built utilizing a Microsoft operating system
- Every City workstation is equipped with Microsoft Office which includes Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Outlook
- Additional programs used throughout the City are Microsoft Project, OneDrive, Teams, MS BI and SharePoint
- The City maintains a substantial number of enterprise application databases within Microsoft SQL Servers

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- SHI Government Solutions is a certified Microsoft partner and pricing is through the Texas Department of Information Resources contract DIR-TSO-4092
- □ The annual cost of the 3-year Microsoft Enterprise Agreement is \$511,999.46

- Do not enter into Microsoft Enterprise License Agreement
 - The City will not be able to update software and proper licensing
- Enter into Microsoft Enterprise License Agreement for a 3-year term of \$511,999.46
 - This will provide the City with the latest versions of software and proper licensing

Recommendation

Staff recommends the City Council authorize the City Manager, or designee to execute a contract for the procurement of a Microsoft Enterprise Agreement from SHI Government Solutions using the DIR contract DIR TSO-4092, and further that the City Manager, or designee be expressly authorized to execute any and all change orders or supplemental agreement within the amounts set by state and local law.
