



INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH CTCOG - HHW

Background and Conclusion

- ❑ The City of Killeen has a history of hosting Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection events going back more than a dozen years.
- ❑ Some events have been sponsored by CTCOG with funds received from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and some sponsored solely by the City of Killeen.
- ❑ This event will afford the residents of Killeen and the entire CTCOG region the opportunity to dispose of hazardous products while protecting our common watershed (South Nolan Creek) and preserving our water resources for current and future generations.
- ❑ The estimated cost to the City of Killeen for the February 3, 2018, event is approximately \$17,000
- ❑ Funds have been budgeted for FY18 and are available in the Refuse Disposal Costs account (540-3470-439.50-40). The CTCOG will also provide \$20,000 in funding to allow for the participation of the entire CTCOG region.

Recommendation

- Staff recommends that City Council authorize the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of Killeen and the Central Texas Council of Governments (CTCOG).
- This agreement will provide the City of Killeen with \$20,000 to pay for a HHW event in Winter or Spring 2018.
